



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS for WARRANTY:

Congratulations on purchasing your new EXlites Bollard Light Head System .

This factory backed warranty covers the bollard light head for **5 years (1 year on Battery for Solar)** from the date of installation *see note (c) for 100% replacement. Your warranty card must be returned within **14 days** of installation. Failure to do so will **void** your warranty. This warranty covers all defects in material and workmanship of this product.

Please take a moment to carefully read the following conditions:

- Your system must be installed by a qualified Electrician in accordance with Australian Standards and State Legislation for AC and qualified Tradesman for Solar. Failure to do so will **void** the warranty.
- For Solar Installation Lanolin Grease or a similar product must be applied to the battery terminals and connector/s wiring to protect against rust, corrosion from moisture or other associated emissions from any substance used to install the bollard mounting pole to its placement point and the bollard mounting pole is excluded under this warranty.
- Solar Bollard must be placed in a position that will have peak sunlight for a minimum of 5 hours per day.
- An O-Ring or some type of seal/sealant must be used to ensure water tight installation between the bollard light head and the actual bollard.
- Warranty does not cover damage resulting from accident, misuse, abuse, theft, neglect, product modification, and improper installation, incorrect line voltage, or unauthorized repair.
- Warranty does not cover damage occurring in shipment (claims must be presented to the carrier).

WARRANTY DETAILS

- This warranty applies only to mainland Australia, New Zealand or South Pacific Islands.
- This warranty does not cover service consequent upon accident, alteration, misuse, voltage supply problems, fire, floods or Acts of God.
- This warranty is valid only where installation is effected within six (6) months of original purchase and is accordance with the conditions stated on this warranty card.
- This warranty does cover the costs of transport of faulty unit replacement if the unit is located within areas serviced by the company or its agents. But does not cover the cost of return of the faulty unit which will be born by the purchaser.
- This warranty does not cover labour costs.
- This warranty does not cover water ingress / damage occurring / starting from within the actual bollard then effecting the bollard light head.
- This warranty is the only express warranty given by the company. No person has the authority to change or to add to these obligations and liabilities.
- The company shall not be liable for consequential damage or any loss suffered through or resulting from the non operation or ineffective operation of the product.
- The company reserves the right to determine whether there are any defects in materials or workmanship.
- This warranty is given by **EXlites** in addition to and not in place of such rights as you may have at law.

213 Bollard Head Polycarbonate (Makrolon) material cleaning instructions

Normal cleansing process

Cleaning against:

Mud, ash, dust, powders, food, drink, oil, blood stain, animal corpse and other non-adhesive and non-corrosive stains.

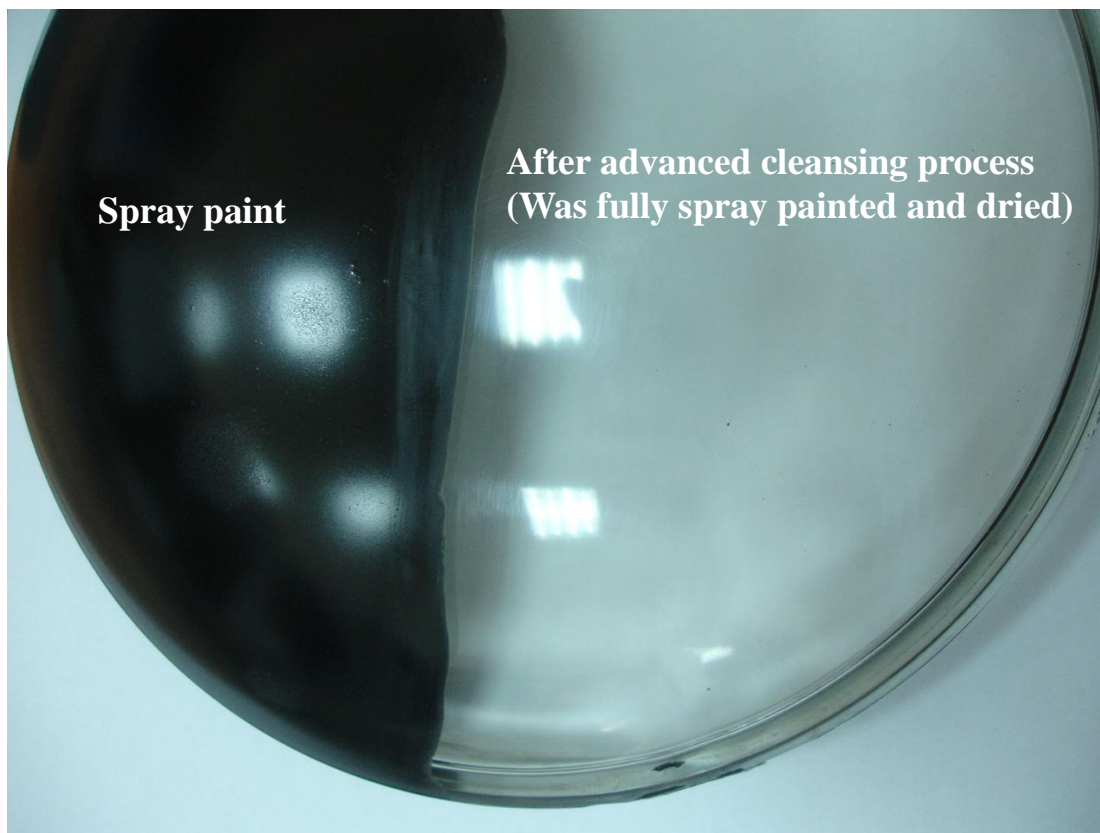
1. Use clean water to wash off dirt.
2. Second, use Glass detergents or dishwashing liquid with water and spray onto the PC bollard head.
3. Use non-textured soft fabrics and smudge gently towards one direction to clean up the bollard head.
4. Rinse with clean water again and dry with non-textured soft fabrics again.

Advanced cleansing process

Cleaning against:

Spray paint, Markers and all other acidic ink and adhesive stains.

1. Apply **Ethanol** (Industrial use pure Alcohol) onto fine-textured soft fabrics and smudge off stains with force towards one direction until all acidic and adhesive stains are removed.
2. Wash with Glass detergents or dishwashing liquid with water and spray onto the PC bollard head.
3. Rinse with clean water again and dry with non-textured soft fabrics again.
4. Apply Fine Wax to fix up scratches and polish the surface to regain cleanness and cleanness.



Warning:

- Spray paint and other acidic liquids will slowly corrode PC surfaces, the advanced cleansing process must proceed immediately when this has been discovered to of happened.
- The advanced cleansing process may not be able to restore 100% due to the PC surface has already been damaged by acidic materials.
